On behalf of the West Virginia Public Employees Grievance Board and in accordance with *West Virginia Code* § 6C-3-3, I am pleased to submit the Grievance Board's Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2013.

The report provides the following data:

- The number of grievances against each employer;
- The types of grievances, level of resolution and costs;
- The number of grievances granted, denied or resolved by other means; and
- The caseload of each administrative law judge, the type of grievance, the number of grievances resolved and the number of decisions issued.

During Fiscal Year 2013, 2,126 were filed. 1,977 grievances were processed at Level 1; 15 at Level 1 Defaults; 298 at Level 2; and 314 at Level 3. Please note that post-filing consolidation results in fewer proceedings than the number of original grievances.

The Board strives to resolve grievances fairly, consistently and as expeditiously as possible. Continuances at the rates of 29% for mediations and 56% for hearings impede that goal and increase the workload for support staff.

During Fiscal Year 2013, 228 Level 3 evidentiary hearings were conducted; 11 were submitted for review based on the Level 1 hearing record; and 212 decisions were issued.

During Fiscal Year 2013, 316 grievances were closed at Level 2. 59 were closed as Successful and 36 were closed as Unsuccessful but were not appealed to Level 3. With the average cost of a Level 3 hearing of 1,747.03, these 95 mediations represent a potential cost avoidance (of a Level 3 hearing) of more than \$165,967.85.

The Board is pleased to report that cumulatively, from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2013, 404 mediations were successful and 217 unsuccessful mediations were not appealed. Together, they represent a cost avoidance of \$1,084,905.63.
